Code of Conduct

VAUGHAN MILLS, including its designated roadways and parking lot, is private property. The following Code of Conduct is set forth for the purpose of protecting Vaughan Mills' legitimate business interests and to ensure the safety and security of our customers.

Your entry constitutes your consent to abide by the following rules governing conduct, traffic and parking:

- 1 Using physical force, obscene language, obscene gestures, or racial, religious or ethnic slurs.
- 2 Physically or verbally threatening any person, fighting, annoying others through noisy or boisterous activities or by unnecessary staring, by following another person through Vaughan Mills or by using sexually explicit language or conduct, or in any other way creating a disturbance which interferes, disrupts or endangers Vaughan Mills patrons or its commercial function.
- 3 Running, skating, skateboarding, bicycling, obstructing or interfering with the free flow of pedestrian traffic or with other patrons' view of windows and other tenant displays, or assembling for the purpose of disturbing the peace or committing any unlawful act.
- 4 Creating litter, or throwing, discarding, or depositing any paper, glass or other matter of any kind on Vaughan Mills property, except in designated trash receptacles.
- 5 Defacing, damaging or destroying any real or personal property constituting part of or located at Vaughan Mills and belonging to Vaughan Mills, its patrons, or its tenants, including writing, spraying, scratching, or otherwise affixing graffiti on such property.
- 6 Small, domestic pets are welcome, but must be carried at all times and be in the care and control of their owners (with the exception of animals in the company of and trained to assist customers with disabilities).
- 7 Yelling, screaming, singing, playing of musical instruments, radios or tape players, or otherwise communicating in a manner which creates noise of sufficient volume to impinge on the hearing or peace of other patrons of Vaughan Mills.
- 8 Engaging in non-commercial expressive activity without the proper prior written permission of the management of Vaughan Mills.
- 9 Soliciting money or other contributions or donations, or distributing commercial advertising or promotional materials of any kind, or offering samples of items which are sold, available for sale, or available in exchange for donation or contribution.
- 10 Selling of new or used merchandise without written permission from Vaughan Mills management to do so.
- 11 Failing to be fully clothed or wearing apparel which is likely to offend, provoke a disturbance or embroil other groups or general public in open conflict.
- 12 Sitting on floors, planter, handrails, stairs, trash receptacles, retail mobile carts, displays or decorative structures.
- 13 Possessing any open can, bottle or other receptacle containing any alcoholic beverage, except in areas specifically designated for the consumption of alcohol.
- 14 Loitering, delaying, lingering, or remaining idle at Vaughan Mills without any useful business for being present.
- 15 Photographing or videotaping the interior or exterior of Vaughan Mills for commercial purposes.
- 16 Engaging in any unlawful activity or behaviour.
- 17 Smoking, in any form, inside Vaughan Mills is prohibited.
- 18 Possession or carrying of any firearms, simulated firearms, or weapons of any kind, openly or concealed, with or without a permit.

If you fail or refuse to follow this Code of Conduct, you will be asked to leave Vaughan Mills. If you fail or refuse to leave Vaughan Mills when requested to do so, you will be arrested and prosecuted for Criminal Trespass. You may be permanently banned from Vaughan Mills for your failure to comply with this Code of Conduct.
